(Access is limited, 110v only.) All electrical cords used must be three-wire grounded, UL-Approved, and rated for outdoor use. The 4th of July Committee/City of Sierra Madre may restrict the use of heating and/or cooking appliances due to their high wattage. Electric warming units, frying pans, large coffee pots, and other appliances may not be permitted if excessive electrical load cause circuit breakers to trip.

Participants agree to abide by all rules and regulations set forth by the 4th of July Committee and the City of Sierra Madre. All booths must be operated by and staffed by business listed above. Participants will provide their own booths, supplies, and trash containers. Participants will be responsible for cleaning all trash in and around their booth area. Participants selling food/beverage are responsible for conforming to

all applicable rules and regulations set forth by the Los Angeles County Health Department.

INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE In consideration for permission to participate in the Sierra Madre 4th of July Events both pre and post parade on July 3, 2019 and July 4th, 2019 the undersigned hereby covenant and agree to indemnify, defend and save harmless the Sierra Madre 4th of July Committee and the City of Sierra Madre, each of their officers, directors, members, agents, servants, volunteers, representatives and employees, and all other participants in the Sierra Madre 4th of July activities and Parade from ANY and all claims, demands or liability which the aforementioned parties may sustain as a result of ANY claims, demands, cause of action, costs of judgments and/or other occurrences which may arise from the undersigned's participation in the Sierra Madre 4th of July activities and Parade. The undersigned on behalf of themselves, or sponsoring group or organization, further (1) assumes the risk of any and all personal injuries and property damage which the undersigned may suffer as a result of participation in the parade or festivities; (2) waives his/her right to sue the aforementioned parties relating to any parade and activities; and (3) covenants with the aforementioned parties to forever refrain from instituting, pressing or in any way aiding any claim, demand or cause of action, for damages, costs, loss of services, expenses or compensation for, on account of, or in any way arising from or hereafter to arise from the undersigned's participation in the said parade and activities.
